This will let me put all my time into what I love the most, working directly on advocacy to help our watershed and community thrive and adapt to climate change. Our primary goal with this change is providing more time to manage floodplain restoration projects, create a watershed wide arundo removal coalition, and encourage and support more groundwater recharge projects to create a more climate resilient water supply.

The reorganization will also prepare Riverkeeper for succession and allow the Board of Directors and I to support a new Executive Director and ensure their success, while also expanding our work.
